Crosson in Denial Of Having Warned Rogers and Post

Joe Crosson, famed mercy flier of the Arctic wastes in which Will Rogers and Wiley Post crashed to their death, today had denied he warned the pair against their fatal flight to Point Barrow.

Amon G. Carter, Fort Worth, Texas, publisher, here for the funeral today, declared the report that Crosson had warned Post against the Point Barrow flight because of weather conditions, "was an error."

Crosson, Carter declared, also said he did not refuse an invitation to accompany the pair on the flight to Point Barrow.
