

Memorial Day In Rogers' Honor

Will Rogers Memorial Day will be observed on November 4, 1936, at the Texas Centennial Exposition in Dallas.

This day, which is the anniversary of the famous actor-humorist's birth, will be observed in recognition of his service during his lifetime in behalf of the crippled children of Texas.

A special program honoring Rogers' memory, which will include the singing of his old favorite Southwestern cowboy songs, is being arranged. Mrs. Rogers and other members of his family will be invited.

Rogers was particularly interested in the celebration of Texas' Centennial of Independence because of his kinship to Tiana Rogers, Cherokee Indian princess, who was the wife of Sam Houston, leader of the Texas revolutionary forces in 1836 when Texas won her freedom.
