## Will Rogers Memorial Fund Campaign Will Be Closed In Few Days

Only a few days remain for completing the Will Rogers Memorial Fund in this county, while contributions have been liberal there are many who have not contributed who doubtless expect to do so before the campaign closes. These are requested to turn in whatever amount they wish to contribute now, accounts are being carried for the fund at each of the three Weatherford banks, so all that is needed to leave the money at the bank where you do business.

A letter has been received by the county chairman, from Mr. James R. Record, associate chairman for the state. Mr. Record announces that eight by ten photos of Mr. Rogers will be placed on sale for \$1.00 each and all that is received from the sale of these will go directly to the fund as the Star Telegram is producing the pictures and donating them to the fund. It is expected that a supply of these will be received here in the next day or two. This is one of the favorite pictures of Will Rogers and bears his signature.

Men, women and children in all walks of life have contributed to this fund, this being an eloquent tribute to the popularity of Will Rogers who touched the hearts of the people of America as few men have ever done. Among the contributors here have been two widows, neither of whom are blessed with too much of this worlds goods, and who gave \$1 each. Last week the boys of the agricultural class in the High School here gave an athletic entertainment for the benefit of the fund, and the dimes of the children and others who attended the event amounted to a substantial contribution.
