Texas-Oklahoma Rogers Fund Tilt Slated Here

Plans for a football game between the strongest high school teams of Texas and Oklahoma for the benefit of the Will Rogers Memorial Fund are nearing completion. The scrap is slated to be held in Fort Worth on Jan. 4.

A delegation of business men from Pauls Valley, which boasts an undefeated and untied club this year, were visitors here Tuesday and conferred with Amon G. Carter, state chairman of the Rogers Fund. Governor Marland of Oklahoma has designated Pauls Valley as the Sooner team. The delegation from that city here Tuesday included State Senator Homer Paul, J. M. Field and George Wacker.

"We have the strongest high school team in the Southwest," the visitors said. "We are anxious to prove to Texas that this is so and are ready to play any club in Texas."

No opponent for Pauls Valley has been named. The playoff for the Texas title still has two weeks to run and the selection of the Texas team will not be made until that time.
