Dear Mr. Carter:

At a meeting yesterday of the Executive Committee of the Oklahoma Will Rogers Memorial Committee I was requested to get in touch with you and other members of the Executive Committee relative to final disposition of funds raised in the campaign. There is always the danger of propositions like this dragging on without accomplishing the purpose for which they are intended.

It was our understanding that the money raised nationally was to be equally divided between Oklahoma and California. It seems to me that the quickest and easiest way out of this would be by resolution passed by mail vote, authorizing the division of these funds and payment to the proper corporate organization in these two states.

I will appreciate your frank opinion on this matter and an early reply will help, as there is some discontent over the final results.

May I add in closing that we all feel deeply indebted to you for your share in the limited success that we have had.
