Will you please have a check issued for \$35.00 to Mr. Carter to reimburse him for a check he has given Glenn Smith, Attorney, 906 Dan Waggoner Building, in payment for one month's rent, June 25th to July 25th, on an apartment at 600 Monticello Drive, which is to be occupied by Emil, representative of Mrs. Will Rogers, who will have charge of the Will Rogers exhibit during the Centennial.

The agreement with Mrs. Rogers is that the Centennial will pay Emil \$50.00 a week and his expenses which includes apartment rent of \$35.00 a month plus the utility bills, except water, and arrangements are to be made for some kind of a small car, possibly a Chevrolet, for his use in getting to and from the Centennial grounds during the time the Rogers display is on exhibit.
