Prof. Gaines and Chambers will leave Fort Worth on June 4 for several months of collaborative scientific research at the University of Pennsylvania. Prof. Chambers will remain with this university for at least a year and Prof. Gaines will return in time for the fall term at T. C. U. Prof. Gaines will direct the installation of his magnetostrictive source of intense sound, and Profs. Chambers and Gaines will collaborate in extension of the applications of their sonic milk sterilizer and emulsifier. Together they will initiate a number of lines of physical and bio-physical research in the field of intense audible sound especially looking toward its application in medicine. The research will be done in the School of Medicine under the Eldridge Reeves Johnson Foundation and is being financed by the Department of Pediatrics of the University of Pennsylvania.
