Dear Governor:

The enclosed check amounting to \$1,760.61, represents half of the net proceeds of the interstate high school football game played in Fort Worth, January 4, 1936, by the Paul's Valley and Breckenridge high school teams for the benefit of the Will Rogers memorial fund.

Since the game, the money has been on deposit in the First National Bank in Fort Worth. Senator Homer Paul of Paul's Valley and Morton Harrison of Claremore have requested me to deliver the Oklahoma half to you as Governor of Oklahoma. Mr. Harrison explained that this was perfectly satisfactory to Paul's Valley and that the Paul's Valley committee would be given proper credit for that amount. Senator Paul confirmed the arrangement by telephone. Accordingly, the fund is now being divided in half between Texas and Oklahoma. Mr. Graham of your office indicated that he would advise Mr. Harrison and Senator Paul as soon as the check is delivered.
