

This check was presented to the Will Rogers Memorial Commission in New York Wednesday by Amon Carter, Texas state chairman and national vice

chairman. The Texas response to the memorial appeal really was over \$65,000, the difference in the amount on the check and in the total having been sent

direct to National Treasurer Jesse Jones. The Texas sum was a 100 per cent donation, all expenses of the campaign having been privately defrayed by

friends of the late philosopher-humorist. The commission now is in session in New York to decide on the proper memorial.
