
Dear Mr. Carter:

I was very much gratified to receive your letter of March 31 indicating that in all probability you and Mr. Jones would be able to meet with the Board of Regents sometime between May 15 and June 1 for the purpose of presenting the \$60,000 gift to The University of Texas for the endowment of a Will Rogers Memorial Scholarship Fund.

It has long been the custom of the Board of Regents to have a meeting in Galveston, Texas at the time of the Commencement at the Medical School. The date of the Commencement this year has been set for May 31 and it is certain that the Board will hold a meeting either on May 30, 31, or June 1 in Galveston.
