

Announcement of the results of the Nation-Wide Test of  
Spring 1932, and the division of the present  
Juniors under the Pre-junior Plan as modified.

November 15, 1932

1. The revision of the Pre-junior Plan was adopted finally by the Cabinet on November 3, after much careful study. A full statement was sent with the Faculty Bulletin, November 4. The new plan provides for a list of juniors who are to be accepted as Honors Candidates, and another list of General Candidates. These lists are furnished herewith.
2. The Nation-Wide Test Scores are in terms of relation to a median, and are difficult to interpret, except by careful study. Later, each student may be informed how well he did. For the present purposes the total score only is used, and that by rank. In column 2 below, e.g. No. 1 is the student who made the highest total score, No. 2 the student who made the next highest, no. 193, the lowest, etc.
3. Basis of Division. The 192 sophomores were ranked for their T.C.U. grade index (see col. 3) and for their Nation-wide total score (see col. 2), their two ranks combined (col. 4).

All students who ranked higher than the median 96 (i.e. a lower number) were classified as Honors Candidates except those whose T.C.U. grade index was lower than 1.50 ( $C\frac{1}{2}$ ). By this test, there are 66 Honors Candidates.

4. Uses of this list. The uses and significance of this division will need to be wrought out gradually by experience. The Department staffs should consult concerning the adaptation of methods, etc. The present message is just to announce the names.

The list includes even those who are not in T.C.U. this session. It does not include Transfer Juniors.
