All teachers will be concerned in cooperating with the Nation-Wide Tests on Wednesday and Thursday, April 19 and 20 (also Friday 9 to 11 only). All sophomores are required to take these tests, so their presence at the tests will count for presence at any classes where they are regularly due.

All regular sophomore classes (numbered in the 20's) will naturally have to be dismissed for the two days. All sophomores in other classes will be excused and counted present if they take the tests. Teachers should make this clear to their sophomores.

On Friday at 9 and 10 o'clock the foreign language tests will be given. This includes about 90 students only, so classes will not be dismissed, but the students involved will be excused.

The tests will be held in Brite Building, the students reporting at 8 a. m. in the Brite Chapel, then divided out to six rocms. The teachers using those rooms will hold their classes in Main Building, as already assigned.

<u>Foreign Language</u>. Students who have no college foreign language, or who are now taking the first year (11) will omit the foreign language test on Friday 21.

All other tests will be taken by all sophemores,

Attendance on the test will count for attendance on the classes that come during the hours when the student is in a test. Absence from the tests will give the student an "I" grade in his classes.
