- 4. Require student to return "Petition for Candidacy", and "Advisory Recommendation Slip" and "Course Card" to the Registrar's office.
- 5. Use "Daily Schedule" blank for your own convenience and record, retaining it in your file for reference.
- 6. Every department is expected to have regular office hours posted, includeing some morning hours and at least two or three afternoon periods per week.
