REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR MAJOR PROFESSORS

1. Maintain office hours 9 to 12 A. M. and 1:30 to 4:30 P. M. Friday and Saturday, September 14 and 15.
2. With "Petition for Candidacy" and Advisor's Recommendation Slip" in hand write on the left side of the letter your recommendation covering all courses that the student should carry this year.
3. Require student to fill out the "Course Card" completely for both fall and spring semesters. When this has been done, sign "Course Card" with "OK" and your initials on both fall and spring sections of the card.
4. Require student to return "Petition for Candidacy", and "Advisory Recommendation Slip" and "Course Card" to the Registrar's office.
5. Use "Daily Schedule" blank for your own convenience and record, retaining it in your file for reference.
6. Every department is expected to have regular office hours posted, including some morning hours and at least two or three afternoon periods per week.

REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR FACULTY COUNSELORS

1. Maintain office hours in the room assigned 9 to 12 A. M. and 1:30 to 4:30 P. M., Friday and Saturday, September 14 and 15.
2. Make sure that "Entrance Credits" and "Information Blank" are in hand.
3. When student is referred to you, assist him in filling out his "Course Card" in full detail both for fall spring semesters. (Follow tables in catalog.)
4. Make sure the student has a copy of the card for his own record.
5. Be sure to include "P.T." on Course Card of every Freshman and Sophomore.
6. When the "Course Card" is completed, mark it "OK" and sign your initials. Retain all data until called for by someone from the Registrar's office.
7. Use the "Daily Schedule" blank for your own convenience. It becomes your copy of the student's schedule and should be retained as a basis of further counsel.
