

Mr. Carter :

The Santa Fe is willing to make up a special ~~#####~~ ^{Star-Telegram} thirteen car train here and operate it as a special as far as the Oklahoma line or to Gainesville. But the officials say that they must pick up some revenue freight at Gainesville and run it into Wichita, Kansas, where all the other cars are being concentrated.

They say ,however, that the train can still be called The Star-Telegram special.

We can fill the thirteen cars as follows:

Ten cars of white flour, which Universal Mills quotes at \$4,344 per car.

Three cars of mixed Texas products, which Tyler and Simpson can furnish (knocking off their 6 percent profit) for \$15,503.

This would give the necessary thirteen cars.

Santa Fe superintendents here and in Galveston say that they have no authority to take the train beyond Gainesville .That would have to be authorized by Chicago.

There will be a number of other cars in here tonight and tomorrow and all will be sent to Wichita and combined there as one big lone train into Chicago for delivery to the C. & O.
