

# Gen. Ike to Unveil Will Rogers' Statue

## Oklahoma to Pay Annual Tribute To Beloved Son

Claremore, Okla., Nov. 3 (AP). Oklahoma will pay its annual tribute tomorrow to the memory of its most beloved son, the late Humorist Will Rogers, this time with the help of the entertainment world.

The occasion is the birth anniversary of Rogers, whose homely wit and philosophy were stilled by an Alaskan airplane crash. Another famous Oklahoman, Aviator Wiley Post, died with Rogers.

As high as 20,000 persons were expected to attend the celebration, which is being sponsored by the Variety Clubs of America, Fraternal organization of enter-
