- 11:00 A.M.—Leave Fort Worth Club, with motorcycle escort, proceeding on Throckmorton, to West Belknap, to North Henderson, to Jacksboro Highway, to Roberts Cutoff, turning on Meandering Road to Shady Oak Farm for luncheon.
- 2:00 P.M.—Cars begin loading for departure from Shady Oak Farm at 2:15 p. m. with motorcycle escort, proceeding along Meandering Road to Roberts Cutoff, turning left to Jacksboro Highway, moving south on Jacksboro Highway to White Settlement Road, then west to University Drive, south to West Seventh, west to Camp Bowie, west to Coliseum Drive and south to site of unveiling of Will Rogers statue. General Eisenhower and party and Miss Margaret Truman and party will leave cars at Speakers' Stand. Other cars in official party will park as directed in horseshoc area adjoining site of ceremonies.
- 3:00 P.M.—Unveiling ceremonies for statue of Will Rogers. Immediately after unveiling of statue, members of official party, invited guests and spectators will walk south for view of Will Rogers Memorial Buildings, entering foyer of Will Rogers Memorial Tower and proceedto foyer of Will Rogers Memorial Coliseum for unveiling of Will Rogers portrait. After the unveiling General Eisenhower and party and Miss Margaret Truman and party will proceed to gate entrance in front of Coliseum to enter cars. With motorcycle escort, they will proceed north to Camp Bowie and east on West Seventh to the Fort Worth Club.
- 6:15 P.M.—General Eisenhower and party and Miss Truman and party, with motorcycle escort, will leave Fort Worth Club, going by way of Throckmorton, West Sixth, West Seventh, Camp Bowie and Crestline Road to River Crest Road and the home of Mr. and Mrs. Bruno K. Graf at 800 River Crest Road for reception at 7 p. m.
- 7:30 P.M.—Group will depart from home of Mr. and Mrs. Graf and proceed, with motorcycle escort, to River Crest Country Club for dinner.
- 9:00 P.M.—General Eisenhower and party will depart from River Crest Country Club and proceed, with escort, by way of Crestline, Camp Bowie and West Lancaster to Texas & Pacific Railway Terminal to leave for Washington, D. C., at 10:30 p. m. by train.

10:30 P.M.—Miss Truman will depart by train for Amarillo.
