He did this with out me knowing about it

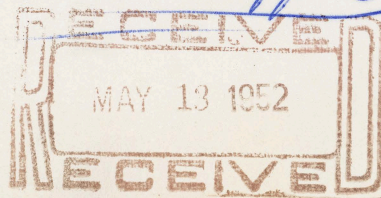
I would like very much to bring this picture
