Re: Will Rogers Equestrian Statue

Gentlemen:

We are submitting herewith our estimate of the Electric work required to light the above statue in accordance with Drawing # L-1 dated 10/25/60 with revisions dated 10/27/60 by Richard Kelly, Illuminating Engineer, 270 Park Ave, New York City, New York.

All the following estimates are based upon securing electrical service from the transformer vault area of The Will Rogers Coleseum Building; said service to be extended underground to the statue site and to all tree lights & pole locations as shown.

Using regular tapered steel poles (not stainless)
Our estimate for the above work is \$ 13,000.00.

Using stainless steel poles as manufactured by the American Flagpole Co., add to the above figure the sum of \$ 12,000.00 making a total of \$ 25,000.00.

Using Aluminum poles of the same approximate demensions, our estimate for the work is \$ 13,960.00.

These figures can be considered as a firm quotation if desired.
