Friday, The President and Mrs. Roosevelt will spend the night with their son, Elliott, and his family at their farm near Benbrook.

The balance of the Presidential party will be at ease and you are invited to be my guests at Shady Oak Farm for an informal dinner to be given in honor of Stephen Early and Marvin McIntyre.

Your rooms will be designated at either the Fort Worth Club or the Worth Hotel. Your baggage will be tagged on the train coming out of San Antonio by Mr. Hugh Scarborough, who will follow the baggage through and have same delivered to your room - number and location of which will be given to you by Mr. Scarborough.

Following the arrival of The President and Mrs. Roosevelt at Elliott Roosevelt's home in the country, the balance of the party will return to Fort Worth to your rooms. After you have had sufficient time for a bath and to get your stories out, cars will be waiting for you on the vacant parking lot in front of the Worth Hotel and you will be motored to Shady Oak Farm for the dinner about 7:30 P.M. When the party is over the cars will be waiting at the farm to bring you back to your rooms at the Club or Hotel, where you will spend the night.

The Presidential train will depart from Fort Worth at 12:30 P.M. Saturday about which, no doubt, you will be advised further by Messrs. Early and McIntyre.
