THE PRESS

The PRESIDENT and the VICE PRESIDENT escorted by the Committee on arrangements, will enter the Capitol Building at the former entrance of the Supreme Court, and they will then be escorted to the room reserved for them.

Mrs. ROOSEVELT and Mrs. GARNER will be escorted to their seats on the President's Platform by White House aides, Mrs. Woodrow Wilson will be escorted to her seat on the President's Platform by Secretary Biffle.

THE PROCESSION TO THE INAUGURAL PLATFORM

The Members of the House of Representatives headed by the Speaker and the Clerk of the House, will proceed to the Inaugural Platform and be seated on the right.

The Members of the United States Senate, headed by the President pro tempore and the Secretary of the Senate, will proceed to the Inaugural Platform and be seated on the left.

The Governors of the States escorted by Assistant Secretary Totty from the Lobby of the Senate Chamber, will proceed to the Inaugural Platform and be seated on the right.

The Chief of Staff of the Army, the Chief of Naval Operations, the Major General Commandant of the United States Marine Corps, and the Commandant of the United States Coast Guard, and their aides, and other invited guests, escorted by Assistant Secretary Foster, from the Senate Reception Room, will proceed to the Inaugural Platform and be seated on the right.

The Diplomatic Corps, escorted by Mr. St. Claire, from the Marble Room, will proceed to the Inaugural Platform and be seated on the left.

The Cabinet, escorted by Mr. Frazier, from the President's Room, will proceed to the Inaugural Platform and be seated on the left.

The Members of the Supreme Court, headed by the Clerk and Marshal, and escorted by Secretary Loeffler, from the Chamber formerly occupied by the Supreme Court, will proceed to the Inaugural Platform and be seated on the left. The Chief Justice will be seated on the right of the President.

The Committee on Arrangements, escorted by Sergeant at Arms Jurney of the Senate and Sergeant at Arms Romney of the House of Representatives, will proceed to the Inaugural Platform in the following order:

- The VICE PRESIDENT AND MR. NEELY
- SENATOR ROBINSON AND REPRESENTATIVE O'CONNOR
- Senator Hale and Representative Doughton
- REPRESENTATIVE SNELL

The Committee on Arrangements will retire and escort the PRESIDENT to the Inaugural Platform. Headed by Sergeant at Arms Jurney of the Senate and Sergeant at Arms Romney of the House of Representatives, they will proceed in the following order:

PROCEEDINGS ON THE INAUGURAL PLATFORM

The Committee on Arrangements will be seated on the President's Platform.

The Marine Band will play "Hail to the Chief."

The PRESIDENT will proceed to the entrance of the President's Platform, additionant device

Prayer by Reverend Doctor ZeBarney T. Phillips.

The VICE PRESIDENT will take his place at the Speaker's Stand.

The Marine Band will sound ruffles.

SENATOR JOSEPH T. ROBINSON will administer the oath of office to the VICE PRESIDENT.

The VICE PRESIDENT and SENATOR JOSEPH T. ROBINSON will retire to their seats.

The PRESIDENT will take his place at the Speaker's Stand.

The Marine Band will sound ruffles.

The CHIEF JUSTICE will administer the oath of office to the PRESIDENT.

The PRESIDENT will then deliver his inaugural address.

Benediction by Right Reverend John A. Ryan, D. D.

The VICE PRESIDENT will take his place at the Speaker's Stand at the side of the PRESIDENT.

The Marine Band will play the Star Spangled Banner.

The Committee on Arrangements headed by Sergeant at Arms Jurney of the Senate and Sergeant at Arms Romney of the House of Representatives will escort the PRESIDENT and the VICE PRESIDENT from the President's Platform, with the PRESIDENT and the VICE PRESIDENT preceding the Committee in the following order:
