Dear Mr. Carter:

On the 5th of September, the construction contract for the Library building was awarded to John McShain, Inc., a Philadelphia construction firm.

At the last meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Library Corporation it was decided that since the total funds necessary are not yet on hand, underwriters' agreements should be executed as tangible evidence to the contractor that he is assured of reimbursement for the full cost of his work. Accordingly, an agreement form was sent to you on August 16, and we hope that you will execute it and return it to us at your earliest convenience. The contractor has agreed to begin work immediately in order that the exterior of the building may be completed before the arrival of cold weather.

Our public campaign is proceeding satisfactorily and we plan to concentrate upon its completion during the next few weeks. At this time it appears highly possible that the full amount necessary can be raised in this manner.
