DEAR MR PRESIDENT I AM HERE ON THE INITIAL TRIP OF THE  
AMERICAN AIRLINES' NEW SERVICE TO MEXICO CITY AND MONTERREY.  
THIS NEW SERVICE HAS BEEN RECEIVED WITH OPEN ARMS BY THE  
MEXICAN GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS AND BUSINESS INTERESTS AND IT  
SHOULD BE THE MEANS OF FURTHER CEMENTING THE FRIENDLY RELA-  
TIONS BETWEEN THIS GREAT COUNTRY AND THE UNITED STATES.  
WHAT THEY SEEM TO WANT HERE NOW IS A FURTHER ENLARGEMENT  
OF THE SERVICE. THE MEXICAN PEOPLE ARE FINE HOSPITABLE  
FOLKS, THOROUGHLY PATRIOTIC AND ON THEIR TOES TO HELP WIN  
THE WAR AND I HOPE THE UNITED STATES GIVES THEM EVERY HELP  
POSSIBLE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. MY BEST AND KINDEST REGARDS
