

Send the following telegram, subject to the terms on back hereof, which are hereby agreed to

Fort Worth, Texas, November 8, 1944

President Franklin D. Roosevelt, The White House, Washington, D.C.

My dear Mr. President: The magnificent victory of Tuesday is America 's indorsement of your conduct of the war and America's belief that you, better than any other individual, can safely and successfully steer us to the long cherished goal of international cooperation to end war. I am sure it is the hope of every patriotic American, as it is mine, that Providence will spare you to carry out this program and likewise it is the duty of every patriotic American to support you and your administration to that end. My heartiest congratulations on the victory and to you personally. Sincerely.
