Thanks for copy of your wire to President Truman. I enjoyed reading it, and concur in the forceful manner in which you argued the pertinent and controversial points between labor and management. When and if the controversy between General Motors and labor unions is settled, it is my hope that a satisfactory formula will have been worked out which will be acceptable to all major industries in arranging a wage scale for the labor it employs. I am reasonably confident that when the Navy releases its control over the refining industry, we will again be confronted with either strikes or complicated arbitration.

Mr. Adams advised me at Christmas time that you had a package for Ben and me which was in Mr. Carvey's custody. The two packages were delivered to me by our Mr. Foster, and I thank you very much for the fine Christmas present. Scotch is a scarce article in Houston.
