Dear Mr. President: I am sending you by American Airlines a good old country bushel of Texas Jumbo Elberta peaches grown on Shady Oak Farm in Fort Worth PERIOD Shady Oak Farm is probably the only farm in existence which has continuously lost money for more than twenty-five years and never asked for a Government subsidy PERIOD I hope you have a chance to see these beautiful peaches PERIOD Texas is naturally quite proud of its many outstanding products and achievements as well as its part in the war effort PERIOD Incidentally, as I am sure you already know, Texas had about six-hundred and fifty thousand men and women in the service, furnished more than forty-four percent of the total oil supplied by the United States during the war, not to mention more than fifteen percent of the meat PERIOD I trust you are bearing up under these trying times.
