Dear Mr. President: Your dramatic and forceful reaffirmation of American foreign policy and the dismissal of Secretary Wallace is deserving of the highest praise and commendation. We in Texas regard it as one of the most momentous decisions of your administration paragraph

Mr. Wallace's proposed policy of appeasement of Soviet Russia, despite his obvious sincerity of purpose, would have been sheer folly and might well have led to results as disastrous as was Prime Minister Chamberlain's appeasement of Hitler at Munich BRACRAH

Your action can have no effect but to win the respect and admiration of liberty-loving people throughout the world, and to solidify your position in the hearts of the American people BRACRAH

You are doing a magnificent job under the most trying conditions, but you have the loyal support of an overwhelming majority of the thinking folks in this section of the country. Keep up the good work.
