PRESIDENT TRUMAN, WHITE HOUSE, WASHINGTON, D. C.

MY DEAR MR. PRESIDENT: THE SOUTHWESTERN EXPOSITION FAT STOCK SHOW AND RODEO, OLDEST AND LARGEST OF ITS KIND IN THE NATION, OPENS IN FTWORTH THE NIGHT OF MARCH FIFTH.
