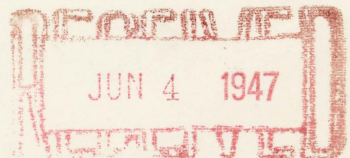
You probably learned soon after sending the message that the engagement was postponed. I was so disappointed at this turn of events, but felt it best to be with the family at that time.

I look forward to being in Fort Worth in the fall, and in the meantime I want you to be assured of my appreciation of your offer of hospitality.

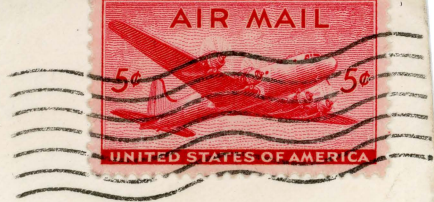
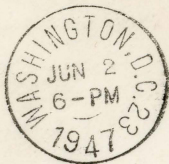
