Dear Amon:

Let me thank you for your letter of July 27.

Events have forced me to conclude that it is necessary to control wages and prices, and I am of the opinion that this responsibility should be directly assumed by the Congress.

The Banking and Currency Committee has not yet reported the Control Bill. I do not know what it will contain, but, at best, I think it will merely give to the President the power to impose wage and price controls at his discretion.
