WHO ARE THOU THAT REPLIEST AGAINST GOD?** He that believeth not God hath made Him a liar. The responsibility of spending eternity in the LAKE OF FIRE AND BRIMSTONE is yours and **yours alone**. **GOD LOVES YOU—CHRIST DIED FOR YOU. OH, WON'T YOU BELIEVE IT, AND ACCEPT HIM TODAY AS YOUR SAVIOUR?**

STOP AND THINK--YOU HAVE TO MEET GOD SOON--ARE YOU READY?

Please receive this message of warning from a friend who wants you to be saved from the wrath and judgments of God, that are soon coming upon all sinners and unbelievers; upon all who refuse to believe upon His Son Jesus Christ and be saved. The most important thing in your life is to prepare to meet God. "What shall a man give in exchange for his soul?" (Matt. 16:26)

God is a God of love, He is not willing that any should perish, but that all should have everlasting life. However, He is also a God of Justice; all sin and disobedience must therefore be punished and God has decreed that it shall be punished with an ETERNAL PUNISHMENT, unless an atonement is made for it. There can be no atonement, or forgiveness of sins, except through the shedding of blood by someone who is Holy and without sin. "Without the shedding of blood there is no remission." (Hebrews 9:22) The only way that God, in His Justice, could forgive our sins was for someone else, without sin, to die in our place. In His great love and mercy, God sent down from Heaven his only begotten Son, Jesus Christ, who was born of a virgin, and was without sin, to die upon the Cross of Calvary, as an atonement for our sins, if we will only believe in Him, and accept Him as our Saviour.

There are certain conditions, however, that God requires us to meet—He has done His part, now we must do ours. In the beginning of His ministry, Jesus told the people to "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." (Matthew 4:17) It was necessary for the people to repent of their sins and to believe on Him as their Saviour. All through his divine, miraculous life of ministry; preaching, teaching, healing the sick and afflicted, raising the dead, doing all the miracles and wonderful works which He did—finally dying upon the Cross for our sins—His purpose was "to seek and to save that which was lost" if they would only believe. Hear His sweet words of invitation, "Come unto me all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me, for I am meek and lowly in heart, and ye shall find rest unto your souls, for my yoke is easy and my burden is light." (Matthew 11:28-30) Weary soul, you can find rest if you will only come to Him.

After His crucifixion upon the Cross of Calvary, and His resurrection from the dead, Jesus told His disciples to "Go ye into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptised shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned." (Mark 16:15-16) Peter, that great apostle, in preaching to the people on the day of Pentecost after Jesus had ascended back into heaven after His resurrection, told the people to "Repent, and be baptised every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost." (Acts 2:38) The apostle Paul preached "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and thou shalt be saved." (Acts 16:31) The prophet Isaiah said, "Let the wicked forsake his way, the unrighteous man his thoughts; and let him return unto the Lord, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for He will abundantly pardon." (Isaiah 55:7)

We see therefore, that in order to be saved, we must repent of our sins, and believe on the Lord Jesus Christ as our personal Saviour. Repentance implies that the Holy Spirit has convicted us of our sins, of righteousness, and of the judgment to come, and that we are sorry from the bottom of our hearts, that we have sinned against God; we are willing to confess and forsake all of our sins, and to make any restitution that God may require, in order to put our souls right with Him. After you have done your part—after you have whole-heartedly repented of your sins—then you can look up to God in prayer, believing and accepting the Lord Jesus Christ as your personal Saviour, and believe from your heart that God forgives you of all your

sins, according to His promises. Jesus said, "Him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out." (John 6:37)

Wouldn't you like to become a child of God, knowing that your sins are all forgiven, and that you are ready to die, or for Jesus to come? You can, if you will only believe and do what God requires you to do. "Though your sins be as scarlet they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool." (Isaiah 1:18) Jesus is now at the right hand of God in Heaven, and He will forgive you if you will come to Him with your whole heart. You do not have to be in a church to be saved, although an old-fashion church altar is an excellent place to find God. Go to your room, out in the woods, anywhere alone with God, pour out your heart and soul to Him in great earnestness and sincerity; tell Him how sorry you are that you have sinned, and mean it from the depth of your heart, and ask Him to forgive you, and **He will do it.** You must be willing to confess and forsake all of your sins, and make any restitution that is necessary. "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." (1 John 1:9) Pray until you **KNOW** that you are saved; until the Spirit of God bears witness with your spirit that you are a child of God.

Do not let anyone deceive you that you can be saved and go to Heaven in any other way than the Bible teaches. There are many deceptions and false religions in the world today. Joining some church, trying to be good by your own good works, good morals, **OR ANY OTHER BELIEF** will not save us—**IT TAKES THE BLOOD OF JESUS CHRIST**—being "born again" through God's grace and forgiveness. Jesus said, "Ye must be born again." (John 3:7) The Bible says, "If any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold all things are become new." (1 Cor. 5:17) Study the Bible—it **alone** is the **WORD OF GOD.** Jesus said, "Search the Scriptures, for in them ye think ye have eternal life." (John 5:39) Read it carefully, prayerfully, reverently and consistently. Remember, it is God's Word to mankind, written under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit; "Holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost." (1 Peter 1:21) It is forever settled in heaven; not a single word will ever fail. All of its promises, warnings and teachings are absolutely true. Jesus said, "Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away." (Matthew 24:35)

YOUR ETERNAL DESTINY IS AT STAKE. Millions and millions of years (there is no end to eternity) you are to spend either in the **LAKE OF FIRE AND BRIMSTONE** with the sinners and unbelievers, suffering the torments of the damned, or **IN HEAVEN**, enjoying the bliss and happiness of the redeemed. If you are saved, if you have believed on the Lord Jesus Christ, accepted Him as your personal Saviour, and lived faithful and true to Him, then Heaven will be your Eternal Home, where there is no more sin, sorrow, sickness or death. "Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love Him." (1 Cor. 2:9) (To get some idea of heaven please read the 21st chapter of Revelation, the last book in the Bible.) Now, precious soul, won't you please repent of your sins, give Him your heart, and live the rest of your life for Him? How happy you will be through the countless ages of eternity for having done so!

After you are saved, then follow your Lord in water baptism, attend regularly some good, spiritual, fundamental church of your choice; enjoying the worship of God and the fellowship of Christian people of like faith. Pray daily and study your Bible diligently, thereby growing in grace and in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. May God bless you and help you to be a faithful whole-hearted Christian, loving your Heavenly Father, and your Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, with all of your heart, through time and eternity.

JESUS IS COMING SOON

Present world conditions, the fulfillment of Biblical prophecy, proves the nearness of the soon coming of the Lord Jesus Christ after His people, and their translation to Heaven to be with their Lord and Saviour. There is to be a seven-year period of tribulation upon the earth, such as the world has never seen. The Anti-Christ shall appear—he will rule the world—no one will be able to make war with him. The Bible says, "Power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations. And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life." (Revelation 13:7-8) Those who believe in him and accept his mark, in order to buy or sell, will be forever lost. At the end of the tribulation period all nations will be gathered in Palestine for the great battle of Armageddon; Jesus Christ will return to earth, not as the humble Nazarene, but as the **SON OF GOD** in great power and glory, destroying the Anti-Christ and all the armies of the nations. He shall then reign "**KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS**" over all the earth for a period of 1000 years, known as the millennium. At the end of this period the resurrection of the dead will take place, and the **GREAT WHITE THRONE JUDGMENT.** All sinners and unbelievers will be cast into the **LAKE OF FIRE AND BRIMSTONE**—then **ETERNITY WILL BEGIN—TIME WILL BE NO MORE.** Listen to what the Bible says, "And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened; and another book was opened, which is the book of life; and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire." (Rev. 20:11-15)

WHERE WILL YOU BE AT THAT TIME? What good will all your wealth do you then if you are not saved; if your name is not in the "Book of Life"? If you have lived a life of sin, a life of pleasure, lust and unbelief—**WHAT THEN?** The great all-important question then will be, "Is my name written in the Book of Life?" There is only one way for it to be written there—**BELIEVE ON THE LORD JESUS CHRIST AND THOU SHALT BE SAVED.** Won't you please accept Him now as your Saviour before it is too late? The Bible says, "Boast not thyself of tomorrow; for thou knowest not what a day may bring forth." (Proverbs 27:1) **GOD LOVES YOU—JESUS DIED FOR YOU.** Accept Him as your Saviour, Lord and Coming King before it is too late.

HOW LONG IS ETERNITY

Our little finite minds cannot fathom the length of Eternity; ages upon ages, upon ages. Let us take an example to set before us;—If it was possible for a bird to fly to one of the far away planets and back again, and it took **one billion years** to make the round trip, how long would it take the bird, carrying one grain of sand on each trip, to transplant all the grains of sand on the earth to the other planet—how many billions and billions and billions of years? Yet—when it would get finished—**ETERNITY** would just have begun—there is no end!!! Sinner friend, **WHERE WILL YOU SPEND ETERNITY?** In one of two places, **HEAVEN**, or the **LAKE OF FIRE AND BRIMSTONE.** **WHICH WILL IT BE?** It will be in the Lake of Fire and Brimstone unless you repent of your sins, and believe on the Lord Jesus Christ as your Saviour.



THE LOST IN HELL

While Jesus was on earth, He told His disciples that "There was a certain rich man, which was clothed in purple and fine linen, and who fared sumptuously every day; and there was a certain beggar named Lazarus, which was laid at his gate full of sores, and he desired to be fed with the crumbs which fell from the rich man's table." And furthermore he said that, "The beggar died, and was carried by the angels into Abraham's bosom; the rich man also died, and was buried; and *in hell*, he lift up his eyes, being in torments." Luke 16:19-23. Again, we read, "*Hell* hath enlarged herself—without measure; and their glory, and their multitude, and their pomp—*shall descend into it.*" Isaiah 5:14. And Jesus said, "I am he that liveth, and was dead: and behold I live for evermore; Amen; and have the *keys of hell and of death.*" Rev. 1:18.

Why Was Hell Made?

Hell was "*prepared for the devil and his angels.*" Matt. 25:41. In II Peter 2:4, we read, "God spared not the angels that sinned, but cast them into *hell* . . . to be reserved unto damnation."

Who Else Will Be in Hell?

"Then shall he say also unto them on his left hand, Depart from me, *ye cursed*, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels." Matt. 25:41. Also, in Psalm 9:17, "*The wicked shall be turned into hell, and all the nations that forget God.*"

Is There Literal Fire in Hell?

The rich man "*cried and said, Father Abraham, have mercy on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame.*" Luke 16:24. Jesus said: "So shall it be, at the end of the world: the angels shall come forth and *sever the wicked* from among the just, and shall cast them into the *furnace of fire.*" Matt. 13:49-50. And the Apostle John, in relating his vision of the fate of the beast and the false prophet said, "These both were cast alive into a lake of *fire burning with brimstone.*" Rev. 19:20.

Are the Fires of Hell Eternal?

"And the *smoke* of their torment ascendeth up *for ever and ever*; and they have no rest, day nor night." Rev. 14:11. "Where their worm dieth not, and the *fire is not quenched.*" Mark 9:48.

Do Physical Bodies Go into Hell?

Jesus said, "Fear not them which kill the body and are not able to kill the soul; but rather fear him, which is able to destroy *both soul and body in hell.*" Matt. 10:28. "If thine eye offend thee, pluck it out: it is better for thee to enter into the kingdom of God with one eye, than having *two eyes* to be cast into *hell fire.*" Mark 9:47.

Do the Wicked Suffer Pain in Hell?

"The rich man also died, and was buried. And in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and *he cried* and said, Father Abraham, have *mercy* on me, and send Lazarus that he may dip the tip of his finger in *water*, and cool my *tongue*; for I am *tormented* in this *flame.*" Luke 16:23-24. "There shall be *weeping* and *gnashing of teeth.*" Matt. 22:13.

Shall Past Scenes of Earth Be Remembered in Hell?

And Abraham said, Son, *remember* that thou in *thy lifetime receivedst thy good things*, and likewise Lazarus evil things; but now he is comforted, and thou art tormented." Luke 16:25.

AFTER DEATH-- THE JUDGMENT

"It is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment."—Hebrews 9:27. Here is an appointment you must keep. It is an appointment made by God for every human being. It is a double appointment — first to die, and then to appear before the judgment bar of Christ.

It is an appointment that differs from all others. God does not ask if it will be agreeable to us but makes it final and mandatory. "It is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment." "We shall all stand before the judgment seat of Christ." "Every one of us shall give account of himself to God." "How shall we escape, if we neglect so great salvation?"

Whether we reject or neglect this salvation matters not. The consequence will be the same. A Hell of eternal suffering and remorse awaits all who have spurned God's offer of salvation through Jesus Christ. "Turn ye, turn ye from your evil ways; for why will ye die?"

The fate of the unsaved is frightful. But no one need go to hell. Christ gave Himself to ransom us from hell and the grave. If we fight God and reject His word and we utterly refuse to leave off sinning, if we will not believe Scripture and accept Jesus Christ as our Saviour and Lord, if we charge God with sending men to hell when He so loved us that He gave His Son to die for us, if we continue in wilful neglect of this great salvation God has provided for us in His Son, then remember, we send ourselves to hell, and God is not to blame. The facts of hell are all but unbelievably awful and ought in mercy to the unsaved be made clear.

HELL IS: "A lake of fire."—Rev. 20:15. "A place of torments."—Lu. 16:23. "A place where lost souls never die."—Matt. 5:22-29. "A place where sinners drink of the wine of God's wrath."—Rev. 14:10. "A place where the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever."—Rev. 14:11. WHERE IS HELL? AT THE END OF A MISSPENT LIFE.

READ THE BIBLE

The Bible contains:—the mind of God, the state of man, the way of Salvation, the doom of sinners, and the happiness of Believers. Its doctrines are holy, its precepts are binding, its histories are true and its decisions are immutable. Read it to be wise, believe it to be safe, and practice it to be holy.

It contains light to direct you, food to support you, and comfort to cheer you. It is the traveller's map, the pilgrim's staff, the pilot's compass, the soldier's sword, and the Christian's charter.

Here, Heaven is opened, and the gates of Hell disclosed. Christ is its grand subject, our good its design, and the glory of God its end. It should fill the memory, rule the heart, and guide the feet.

Read the Bible slowly, frequently, prayerfully. It is a mine of wealth, a paradise of glory, and a river of pleasure. It is given you in life, will be opened at the Judgment, and be remembered for ever. It involves the highest responsibility, will reward the greatest labor, and condemn all who trifle with its sacred contents.

EARTH'S DESTRUCTION

(BIBLE)

"The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance. But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up. Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ye to be in all holy conversation and godliness, looking for and hastening unto the coming of the day of God, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat? Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness. Wherefore, beloved, seeing that ye look for such things, be diligent that ye may be found of him in peace, without spot, and blameless." II Peter 3:9-14.

NEW HEAVEN NEW EARTH

(BIBLE)

"And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea. And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God. And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain, for the former things are passed away. And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And he said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful. And he said unto me, It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of the fountain of the water of life freely. He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son. But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers and whoremongers, and the sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death." Rev. 21:1-8.

WHAT MUST YOU DO TO BE SAVED?

This is the most vital question in your life. Because of its importance—do not let anything hinder you from making your decision—TODAY. Only the Bible—God's Word—can be your safe guide.

The Bible says, "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and thou shalt be saved." (Acts 16:31) God so loved you that He sent His only begotten Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, to pay your penalty for your sins (which you could never, never pay) if you will only believe in Him, and accept Him as your Saviour. Jesus died on the Cross to take the punishment for your sins, if you will repent and believe on Him. He died for you—that you might not go to Hell—but have Everlasting Life. "The wages of sin is death, but the GIFT of God is eternal life, through Jesus Christ our Lord." (Romans 6:23)

Jesus said, "I am the way, the truth, and the life; no man cometh unto the Father, but by me." (John 14:6) "I am the door; by me if any man enter in, he shall be saved." (John 10:9) You must come to God—in repentance and faith—through Jesus Christ, His Son, and you will receive pardon and cleansing from all your sins; through the precious blood that Jesus shed on Calvary's Cross for you.

Confess to God that you are a guilty sinner, for you have broken His commandments. Confess that you cannot save yourself; that without Jesus Christ as your own Personal Saviour you are hopelessly lost and condemned to Hell. Repent of your sins, confess and forsake them, be sorry for them before God, and ask God to forgive you. Believe the Bible that Christ died for the ungodly; therefore He died for you and paid your sin debt on Calvary's Cross. Believe the glorious news that Christ was raised from the dead, ascended back to heaven, and by the power of God is now able to save all that come to Him. (Heb. 7:25) Rely on God's sure promises. "Him that cometh to me, I will in no wise cast out." (John 6:37) and by faith believe that you are saved by the blood of Jesus Christ, and openly confess Christ with your mouth as your Saviour and Lord. (Rom. 10:9-10)

Before you can be saved, your personal decision must be made. Decide now to become a Christian. GOD LOVES YOU—JESUS DIED FOR YOU. Accept Him as your Saviour by saying, "I take Thee, Lord Jesus, to be my Personal Saviour. Thou didst take my place at Calvary; Thou didst die in my stead as my substitute for my sins, and now, repenting of all my transgressions as a guilty sinner, I receive Thee as my own and only Saviour for Time and Eternity." Be sincere and wholehearted. Pray earnestly and sincerely until you KNOW that God has forgiven you. He has never turned an honest soul away; He will not turn you away if you come to Him with your whole heart, in faith believing. Come to Him today! God bless you and help you.
