
Dear Mr. Carter:

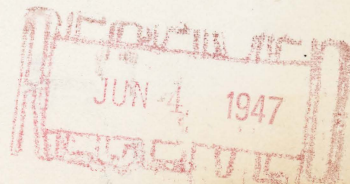
An early reply will be highly appreciated.

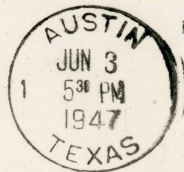
