Dear General:

I am sending by prepaid express to the President an American flag on a standard about four feet high equipped with a motor. The enclosed instructions will show how the flag is to be set up and it can be plugged into any ordinary light connection. So, place the flag on the floor in the President's room, if he does not already have one, and turn the motor on and keep the flag flying continuously. After all that is what our country needs at the present time - sufficient power to keep our flag flying everywhere as well as reinstating it where it has been hauled down.

Please tell the President I am sending this flag along with my best wishes.
