Mr. Carter has shown us your telegram of the 25th as he has copies of all previous correspondence and gone over the same thoroughly with our committee. We are appreciative of the importance of holding the Premiere of "The Westerner" in Fort Worth and of Mr. Carter's interest from the very beginning. The opportunity to finance the expenses of the Premiere in conjunction with our Summer Show is definitely past. The raising of the money for the Summer Show and a large oil convention scheduled for next month renders it impossible for us to go back to the plan originally suggested for raising money for the Premiere. However, we still stand ready to cooperate with you to the best of our ability in preparing the proper local setting for you to stage the Premiere. If you desire, solely at your expense, to bring to Fort Worth the talent and personalities and stage here the Premiere and Beauty Contest in the manner that you, Mr. Farnol and others have suggested in correspondence, then, subject to the execution of a satisfactory written agreement between your principals and the Chamber of Commerce, we will, at our expense, take care of the following: use our best efforts to have holidays declared, as suggested, decorate the city, stage parade, bring in bands for the occasion, hold the large Square Dance with contestants from various West Texas communities, arrange for broadcasting of the latter, and such other entertainment as in the judgment of our committee would seem fitting to this occasion. We to make no claim to the receipts from the theater performances. All proceeds from local activities other than receipts from the theaters to go to us.

Please advise if you wish to send your representatives to Fort Worth to work out details of an agreement. *in accordance with the above.*
