Grid Classic Brings Turnout of Celebrities With Col. Carter in Charge

Col. Amon (Carter of Cartersville) Carter (upper left), was feeling good enough Saturday afternoon to climb out of his box at Ownby Oval and lead the T. C. U. band between halves of the football game that gave his home town boys the conference championship. The nation-wide attention paid to the game is reflected in the picture at the upper right which shows Jesse Jones, chairman of the RFC, and his party. Standing in their box are Fred Florence (left), Mr. Jones, Mrs. Florence, Mrs. Tilford Jones and Mrs. Jesse Jones. Methodist rooters shown at the lower left were displaying less enthusiasm than Colonel Carter. They are, left to right, Dean E. B. Hawk, acting president of S. M. U.; Mr. and Mrs. Ward Powell of Fort Worth, Mrs. Hawk, Mrs. C. C. Selecman and Bishop Selecman, former president of S. M. U. And at the right is no other than Gene Autry in a white hat and coat, smiling at the fans and the photographer. He attended the game with Elliott Roosevelt, but Son Roosevelt was missing when the picture was snapped.
