## NOTE ON PSYCHOLOGICAL EXAMINATION

The scores on the accompanying sheets are those made by the Freshman class on the Psychological examination given during Freshman week. The Q scores are on the quantitative tests; the L scores are on the linguistic tests; the total scores are on the combined tests. While it is thought that the scores give a fair indication of the mental alertness of the student, they should not be considered as equivalent to an I. Q. A wise use of these tests should help in dealing with the Freshman students.

SPECIAL NOTICE ON SELECTIVE SERVICE ACT  
AS IT AFFECTS OUR STUDENTS

An incomplete study of the material placed in our hands causes us to present the following statement for your considerations:

"the group deferment of students provided by the act expires July 1, 1941, and it will, therefore, be necessary for local boards to reclassify all students now in Class 1-D or 1-E prior to July 1, 1941.....Students.....undergoing instruction may be deferred in Class 2-A by the local board where the activity.....is in training or preparation.....essential..... and the registrant is found to be a necessary man...... In applying these.....provisions there must be no deviation from the clear statutory prohibition against group deferments. The local board has full authority and responsibility for deciding whether or not a registrant is a necessary man and whether he should be selected or deferred."

It appears that students in training in the following fields will be considered necessary men: chemistry, and engineering in the following branches.....civil, electrical, chemical and metalurgical, and mechanical. It further appears that students preparing for the following fields will very likely be deferred: agricultural or sanitary engineering, dentistry, pharmacy, physics, medicine, biology and bacteriology, and geology in the following branches...geophysics, meteorology, hydrology, and cartography. The procedure recommended involves a number of details, chief among which is the filling out of a statement of information and an affidavit by the student. The provisions apply to undergraduates as well as seniors.
