AN URGENT ORD!

You will recall in recent issues of the Faculty Bulletin your attention has been called to the requirement that each student attending class must place in the hands of the teacher an "ADMIT TO CLASS CARD". It is quite evident that some teachers are disregarding this administrative requirement. To disregard an important matter of this sort is to create in the minds of the students an attitude of indifference towards settling the account in the Business Oifice. Please check over your cards to make sure that every student now reporting to you, either in class or for private lessons, has placed in your hands an "admit to Class Card" for that particular course. Any error that has been made in either the Registrar's Office or the Fusiness Office will be carefully corrected if the word is sent to the office.

The records show that sixty-nine new students have entered Texas Christian University at the beginning of the second semester, which places our enrollment for the year at approximately the same figure as for one year ago. At the present moment, fifty-eight students dropped out at Mid-Year. Figures relating specifically to military service are not available.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION
