Certain credentials are necessary to validate registrations. Three items are included, viz:

Application Transcript of Statement Course Card

Where a student has not filed all three of these in the Registrar's Office we are unable to approve the registration, therefore the student comes to your class without the "Admit" card which is available through the Business Office when the account has been settled.

Please, therefore, do not permit further attendance in any class after Saturday of this week unless you have in hand the "Admit" card. Just send the student to the Business Office for the cards. In the event he has not completed the three requirements the student will be referred to the Registrar's office for completion of the regular routine.

Flease remember that Saturday is being included this week, according to the announcement in the Faculty Bulletin of last week. We are running short on time in the summer term, particularly the first six weeks. Dean Hall urges the Saturday class this week. Beginning with next Monday the classes will meet five days per week, (Monday through Friday).

The Summer enrollment, for the present at least, looks quite encouraging with about a 10% increase over a corresponding period last year. More Freshmen and Sophomores are registering this summer.
