PLEASE REMEMBER

An "N" grade is permissible only in an emergency and only at mid-semester. (See page 25 in the Catalog)

Where a written examination is given at mid-semester and is missed by the student he must get a permit from the Registrar's Office before the examination can be made up. The fee will be determined in the office. The teacher will go by the permit. Otherwise mid-semester "I" grades may be absorbed later in the course.
