A WORD ABOUT THE SUMMER TERM OF 1943

Teachers are hereby advised that they should not register students for more than six semester hours during either of the six weeks' terms or three semester hours during the three weeks summer term. The only exceptions that can be made to this rule are seniors who may carry as much as 15 semester hours in twelve weeks or those who have a "B" average in the spring semester and who carry courses that can be arranged so as not to cover more than 7 1/2 semester hours in any one period of six weeks. This is a very important matter, and must be followed carefully in keeping with standards agreed upon by the Texas & Southern Association of Colleges,
