SENIORS AND THEIR EXAMINATIONS

3. Grades on these Seniors must be in the Registrar's Office not later than 9:00 A.M., Friday, May 28th. This is a tight schedule. We will depend on the cooperation of everyone and feel sure this will be given.
4. A list of candidates for graduation, May 31, will be published in the Faculty Bulletin of May 20th for your convenience in making this report.
