LECTURE

Add-Ran College of Arts & Sciences

On Thursday evening, December 2, at 8:00 P. M. Dr. Ezequiel Ordonez former Director of the Institute of Geology of Mexico will give a lecture in the University Auditorium on the Mexican volcano, Paracutin. The lecture will be illustrated by colored moving pictures.

Dr. Ordonez is one of the well-known geologists of the western Hemisphere. He is an Honorary member of the American Association of Petroleum Geologists and a famous lecturer and speaks English fluently.

The Volcano Paracutin sprang up in a peasant's corn field last February and is still erupting violently. It is one of the great manifestations of the forces of nature exhibited in our day.

Dr. Ordonez's lecture is sponsored by the Fort Worth Geological Society and the Department of Geology. It is free and open to the public.
