THE V-12 PROGRAM

The Navy has asked congressional authority to transfer its V-12 Officer training program to a permanent R.O.T.C. to provide officer personnel for the post war fleet. The transfer to take effect July 1st, 1945.

The 131 V-12 colleges are to be replaced by 50 R.O.T.C. Units. The Eighth Naval District is to have six. The prospects are about as follows as worked out by Lt. Decker and Messers Sherer and Winton:

Of the seventeen V-12 colleges in the District, six will be unable to qualify for R.O.T.C., since they are rated for only the basic first year course.

Three colleges have R.O.T.C. units.

One other is conceded as sure to get a unit.

Apparently that leaves T.C.U. and six other colleges from which to pick two units.

Naval training will end July 1st in all colleges where R.O.T.C. units have not been established.
