

NAVY PROGRAM:

The Navy has announced (V-12 Bulletin 297 and confirming letter to President Sadler) that it will be impossible to select and commission the new R.O.T.C. units by July 1st.

V-12 Units will continue until the end of October but with the R.O.T.C. program.

Additional officers will be sent to T.C.U. to give the courses in Naval Science and Tactics.

It seems that during the Summer-Fall the heavy pressure on Physics, Mathematics and Engineering Drawing will shift to other areas, principally English 324, Modern Languages 311 and 321, the Social Sciences and advanced pre-medical subjects.
