Illustrated Lecture:

At 8 p.m. on Tuesday evening May 15, Dr. F.M. Bullard, Professor of Geology at the University of Texas, will lecture in the main auditorium of the University on the subject of the Mexican volcano, Paricutin. The lecture is to be sponsored by the Fort Worth Geological Society and the Natural Science Society of T.C.U.

Dr. Bullard has for several years been a summer visiting professor at the University of Mexico, Mexico, D.F. He is a scholarly man and a most pleasing lecturer. This address is admirably illustrated by excellent color moving pictures, is in the popular vein and will be of interest to all.

You will recall that the volcano Paricutin appeared in a corn field in central Mexico some three years ago and in this short time has produced a cone nearly 2000 ft. high. It represents one of the spectacular natural phenomena of recorded history. Dr. Bullard's lecture emphasizes the more recent activities of this great volcano.

You are urged to announce the lecture to your classes and urge all who may be interested to attend.
