A REMINDER:

Grades for graduating seniors and upper-classmen are due in the Registrar's Office not later than 9 A.M. Friday, June 22. Use attached sheet.

Final examinations for all other students are to be given at the last regular class period on Monday or Tuesday, June 25, 26, except in classes where examinations are given at the last laboratory period the previous week.

Grade report sheets, and Admit-to-Class cards containing grades and absence dates are due in the Registrar's Office not later than Thursday, June 28. This will give the office staff only two days in which to get out all reports before the opening of the Summer-Fall Trimester.
