

## A REPEATED WORD

1. PRE-REGISTRATION FEB. 14 and 15

Students now in attendance at Texas Christian University will be registered for the Spring Trimester on Thursday and Friday Afternoons and evenings, February 14 and 15 at the following hours in the Library:

1:30 to 5 p.m.

7:00 to 10 p.m.

Staff members of all departments are to be present for a complete registration. This will make the registration of new students on March 4 and 5 more orderly and will avoid many complications. The pre-registration on February 14 and 15 was decided last week by Heads of all Departments and has been approved by the Administrative Committee. Department heads, please make sure your majors with sophomore standing or above have a petition sheet in hand at time of registration.

2. FACULTY ADVISORS

Students will be wanting to confer with their faculty advisors between now and February 14 concerning their schedules for the Spring Trimester. It will be helpful to faculty and students if the faculty members will place outside their offices a notice of the hours they will be available for conferences. Helping students with their schedules is a good way to increase the number of students who will remain at T.C.U. for advanced courses and a degree.

3. FINAL EXAMINATIONS AND GRADE REPORTS

The dates for final trimester examinations for all students except graduating seniors will be Monday and Tuesday, February 25 and 26 at the regular class hour. In laboratory subjects the examination may be given at the last laboratory period if approved by the Head of the Department.

Examinations for graduating seniors may be given at the discretion of the instructor, and grade sheets and cards must be in the Registrar's office not later than Fri. 22 at 9 a.m. All other grade sheets and report cards are due in the Registrar's office before 5 p.m. Thursday, February 28.
