TO THE FRADS OF ALL DEPARTMENTS

On lednesday, March 27, a stack of questionnaires will be made available to you by my secretary. The purpose of these questionnaires is to help determine the number of students on the campus who will be here for the Summer Session, and the courses they want. Please call the members of your staff together and ask them to do the following:

- 1. Starting at 8:00 a.m. on Thursday, March 28, and in each class thereafter until they have met them all, hand out one questionnaire to each student who has not received one.
- 2. Ask the student to fill out his questionnaire and return it to the instructor at once if the student knows what courses he wants.
- 3. Those students who need more time are to be instructed to return the questionnaire to the instructor not later than April 1 or April 2, depending on whether the class meets on Monday or Tuesday.
- 4. Any student who has received a questionnaire in another class is not to take another copy.
- 5. If all instructors will take the time to give the general requirements for majors and minors in their departments, many students will be able to list the courses wanted in the summer with little or no further consultation. Nevertheless, instructors should make it known where and when students may consult them.
- 6. The Heads of Departments will please be responsible for seeing that all the returned questionnaires are returned to my office not later than Tuesday afternoon, April 2.
- 7. Although the supply of the latest general catalogue has been exhausted, enough copies of the 1944-1945 catalogue are available for the faculty. The list of requirements are contained therein.

Results of the questionnaire vill be made available as soon as possible. Each department will then be asked to review its offerings for the summer school. In addition to the questionnaire it is suggested that each department can obtain valuable supporting evidence by taking a poll in each class as to how many students in each class expect to take the next course in the same subject.

Tell the students the summer schedule vill be posted as soon as possible, and a summer school bulletin vill be issued. The ceneral catalogue of 1946-1947 is in the hands of the printer and should be out in April.

Widespread appreciation has been expressed for the way in which students, faculty and administration cooperated during the recent periods of registration. Your further cooperation and patience will be appreciated.
