YOUR ATTENTION, PLEASE:

1. Preparatory plans for Spring registration call for petition sheets and student record books to be ready for use. Students will bring these to heads of departments and counselors, when and if needed during registration in the Library.

2. Please note in the printed Registration Instructions, available tomorrow or Saturday, the full details of procedure for both new and returning students. Conferences with your majors ahead of time may save you time during the days of registration.

3. Students now in school will register alphabetically in reverse, as you will notice, ie, "Z" first and "A" last.

4. Please remember the examination schedule printed last week. Refer to the notes at the top of that sheet regarding the following items:

- (1) Each exam is scheduled for two hours.
- (2) Turn in both grade sheets and class cards within 48 hours after each examination.
- (3) All grades must be in the Registrar's Office by 9:00 A.M., Monday, January 27.
- (4) Assign numbers to students and post grades outside your offices as soon as each class or section is graded.

5. Each department head will arrange with the members of his staff for service at the Library during the days of registration. Remember we begin at 8:30 A.M., the 27th.

6. The Schedule of Courses for the Spring Semester will be printed on shorter sheets than for the Fall Semester, but on both sides. These will be available in a day or two.
