

MEMO FOR FACULTY

Most of the faculty, I am sure, understands the conditions under which courses in aviation (including flight training) are offered to our students. But, for purposes of clarification, the following statement seems desirable.

The work in aviation thus far has been scheduled through the Evening College. The same procedure is to be followed for a student enrolling in one of these courses as in any other course in the Evening College. In my judgement, a student should select his elective courses with a definite objective in mind; thus if he expects a given course to count within the curriculum of work for a degree, he should secure the consent of his major professor before enrolling in it.
